

Report of the Elections and Boundaries Commission on the Tobago House of Assembly Elections held on Monday 12th January, 2026

1. INTRODUCTION

Election Rule 108(6) of the Representation of the People Act, Chapter 2:01 (the Act) requires the Elections and Boundaries Commission (the Commission) to cause to be printed, after each election, a report giving:

- (a) the number of votes polled for each candidate by polling divisions;
- (b) the number of rejected ballots;
- (c) the number of names on the revised list of electors and on the list of special electors; and
- (d) any other information that it may deem fit to include.

Further, the said rule specifies that a copy of the report shall be forwarded to the Minister responsible for local government, as well as to the Chief Administrator of the Tobago House of Assembly.

Acting in accordance with the said election rule 108(6), therefore, the Commission submits herewith its report on the Tobago House of Assembly Elections held on Monday 12th January, 2026. The data in respect of (a) and (b) above are provided in **Appendix II**. A summary of the information contained in **Appendix II** is given in **Appendix I**, while the requirement at (c) is met in **Appendix III**. Other pertinent information deemed fit for inclusion in the report, in addition to what is contained in this text, can be found in **Appendices IV-XI** inclusive.

2. ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE DATE OF THE ELECTION

The Chairman of the Commission, Mr. Mark Ramkerrysingh was informed of the date of the election being **Monday 12th January, 2026**, via correspondence dated Thursday 4th December, 2025 from Her Excellency, the President of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago.

The correspondence also indicated that *Nomination Day* had been fixed for **Monday 19th December, 2025**.

3. ISSUANCE OF WRITS OF ELECTION TO RETURNING OFFICERS

On Saturday 6th December, 2025, the Chairman of the Commission delivered Writs of Election issued by Her Excellency, the President to the four (4) Returning Officers appointed by the Commission to conduct the poll in the fifteen (15) electoral districts. This activity was held at the Comfort Inn and Suites Hotel, 30 Orange Hill Road, Scarborough, Tobago.

In his address to the newly appointed Returning Officers, the Chairman thanked them for accepting the appointments and stressed the significance of their roles in the democratic process.

Returning Officers were assisted in the execution of their duties by four (4) Election Clerks appointed for this purpose by the Commission, as is provided for in Section 7 of the Act.

4. ELECTORAL REGISTRATION AND REVISED LIST OF ELECTORS

In accordance with the provisions of Section 30 of the Act, a nine-day period of Electoral Registration was conducted from 15th to 23rd December, 2025.

During the period of Electoral Registration, a total of seven (7) new registrations were effected, while one hundred and two (102) notifications of change of address were received.

The Preliminary List of Electors posted, as required, on the date of the commencement of the period of Electoral Registration, reflected an electorate of fifty-three thousand, one hundred and fifty-two (53,152).

Changes made to this list, by way of additions and deletions, resulted in an electorate of fifty-three thousand, two hundred and thirty-nine (53,239) on the Revised List of Electors which was posted on 28th December, 2025.




Figure 1: Changes between the Preliminary and Revised Lists of Electors

Figure 1 below illustrates the changes between the Preliminary and Revised Lists.




Figure 2: Preliminary and Revised Lists of Electors by Electoral District

There were no adjustments to the Revised List; therefore a Supplemental List was not required.

5. NOMINATION DAY PROCEEDINGS

On Nomination Day, 19th December, 2025 forty-two (**42**) candidates were nominated to contest the election by four (**4**) political parties. There were no independent candidates contesting this election.

The number of candidates nominated by each political party, together with the parties' approved symbols are presented in *Table 1* below.




Figure 3: Gender of Nominated Candidates

Of the forty-two (**42**) candidates nominated, thirteen (**13**) were females while twenty-nine (**29**) were males as illustrated in *Figure 3* on the following page.




Figure 4: Gender of Nominated Candidates disaggregated by Political Parties

6. POLLING STATIONS AND STAFFING

One hundred and seventeen (**117**) polling stations were established for the purpose of the taking of the poll in the ninety-nine (**99**) polling divisions which constituted the fifteen (**15**) electoral districts.

A total of seven hundred and ninety-two (**792**) individuals received training in polling station and related poll day activities. Of this number, six hundred and thirty-five

(635), comprising five hundred and seventy-eight (578) females and fifty-seven (57) males, were assigned to work on poll day.

They were recruited to fill the positions of Presiding Officer, Deputy Presiding Officer, Poll Clerk, Officer-in-Charge of the Ballot Box, Information Officer, and Roving Officer.




Figure 5: Gender of Poll Day Staff

7. COMMUNICATION

In accordance with the provisions of the relevant legislation, pre-election advertisements were published in local newspapers and the Gazette. These notices were also disseminated via the Commission’s official website (www.ebctt.com) and social media platform.

Further, the Commission utilised television and radio broadcasts to provide accurate and timely information, aimed at enhancing electors’ awareness and understanding of electoral processes and procedures.

8. CONDUCT OF THE POLL

8.1 Special Voting

Of the fifty-three thousand, two hundred and thirty-nine (53,239) individuals eligible to vote, a total of nine hundred and sixty-nine (969) persons were granted approval to be treated as special electors. This total represents 1.83% of the electorate.

Voting by Special Electors commenced, as scheduled, on Monday 5th January, 2026 at the offices of the respective Returning Officers, while similar activity began on Tuesday 6th January, 2026 at the Special Polling Stations established by the Commission for that purpose. All qualified persons who turned out to cast their ballot during the special voting period were able to do so without incident.




Figure 6: Special Voter Applications vs Turnout

Out of the nine hundred and sixty-nine (**969**) approved special electors, eight hundred and thirty-eight (**838**) individuals cast their votes, representing **86.48%** of the total special electors for this election as illustrated in *Figure 6* below.

8.2 Voting on Poll Day

On poll day, Monday 12th January, 2026, voting commenced as scheduled; there were no major incidents which negatively impacted the voting process. Election Day went as anticipated and all persons wishing to exercise their franchise were able to do so in the stipulated time.

As is customary, Members of the Commission were deployed across the island on poll day in order to monitor operations at polling stations. They reported that the casting of ballots and the counting of votes were generally incident free. In this regard, the Commission was satisfied that poll day arrangements enabled the electorate to exercise their franchise freely and fairly.

9. CHALLENGES TO PRELIMINARY RESULTS

Following the declaration of the preliminary results of the poll by Returning Officers, candidates or their Election Agents filed requests for a recount of the votes cast in two (2) electoral districts. This mandatory exercise, details of which are provided below, was conducted on Tuesday 13th January, 2026.

9.1 Electoral District of Darryl Spring/Whim

The P.N.M. candidate, Mr. Kelvon Morris, requested a general final count of all ballots cast in all polling divisions of the Electoral District of Darryl Spring/Whim.

The process commenced on Tuesday 13th January, 2026 at 3:00 p.m. and was concluded at 8:27 p.m. on the same day.

As a result of the count, the P.N.M. candidate gained three (3) additional votes while the T.P.P. candidate lost two (2) votes. The votes counted for the I.D.A. candidate remained unchanged.

Therefore, the recount did not alter the results of the preliminary count, and Mr. Ricky Michael Joefield, the candidate for the T.P.P., was declared the winner.

9.2 Electoral District of Scarborough/Mt. Grace

The P.N.M. candidate, Ms. Petal Cassandra Benoit, requested a general final count of all votes cast in the Electoral District of Scarborough/Mt. Grace.

The process commenced on Tuesday 13th January, 2026 at 3:05 p.m. and was concluded at 7:12 p.m. on the same day.

As a result of the count, the T.P.P. candidate received one (1) additional vote while the votes counted for the P.N.M. and I.D.A. candidates remained unchanged.

Accordingly, the recount did not alter the results of the preliminary count, and Mr. Trevor Williamson James, the candidate for the T.P.P., was declared the winner.

10. RESULTS OF THE POLL




Figure 7: Voter Turnout

The number of electors exercising their right to vote amounted to twenty-six thousand, nine hundred and eighty-nine (26,989), representing 50.69% of the total number of eligible voters, as shown in *Figure 7* on the following page.




Figure 8: Total Ballots Cast

Of the total votes cast, the number of valid votes polled was twenty-six thousand, eight hundred and eighty-six (**26,886**) or **99.62%** and the number of ballots rejected was one hundred and three (**103**) or **0.38%**, as shown in *Figure 8* below.

The Tobago People’s Party secured the highest number of votes, receiving sixteen thousand, two hundred and thirty-nine (**16,239**) votes, representing **60.40%** of the valid votes cast.

The People’s National Movement garnered ten thousand, four hundred and fifty-nine (**10,459**) votes, accounting for **38.90%** of the valid votes.

The remaining two (**2**) political parties collectively received one hundred and eighty-eight (**188**) votes, equivalent to **0.70%** of the valid votes.




Figure 9: Number of Votes received by each Political Party

Figure 9 below provides a graphical representation of these results, with a detailed breakdown by electoral district available in **Appendix IV**.




Figure 10: Map of Tobago showing the Results of the Poll

The Tobago People’s Party was the only successful party contesting the 2026 Tobago House of Assembly Elections; their candidates having been elected in all fifteen (15) electoral districts. *Figure 10* illustrates the results of the poll.





Figure 11: Gender Distribution in the Tobago House of Assembly
