As required by Rule 108(6) of the Election Rules made under the Representation of the People Act, Chapter 2:01, the Elections and Boundaries Commission hereby submits to you its Report on the Tobago House of Assembly Elections held on 24th November, 1980, giving hereto in Appendix I the number of votes polled for each candidate by polling divisions, and the number of rejected ballots; and in Appendix II the number of names on the Revised List and on the List of Special Electors.
