Rule 108(6) of the Election Rules made under section 161(1) of the Representation of the People Act Chapter 2:01 prescribes in effect, that the Elections and Boundaries Commission (the Commission) shall immediately after each election cause to be printed a report giving:-

- (a) the number of votes polled for each candidate, by polling division;
- (b) the number of rejected ballots;
- (c) the number of names on the revised list and on the list of special electors; and
- (d) any other information that it may deem fit to include therein; and,

in the case of a Municipal Council elections, forthwith forward a copy thereof to the Minister responsible for Local Government.

In compliance therewith, the Commission now submits to you its printed Report on the Tobago House of Assembly Elections held on December 9, 1996. It sets out in Appendix I the number of votes polled for each candidate by polling division and the number of rejected ballots; and in Appendix II the number of names on the revised list and on the list of special electors.

The information contained in Appendices III, IV, V, VI, VII, VIII and IX are provided under Rule 108(6)(d).






