Sir,

Rule 108(6) of the Election Rules made under section 161(1) of the Representation of the People Act Chapter 2:01 prescribes in effect, that the Elections and Boundaries Commission (the Commission) shall immediately after each election "cause to be printed a report giving:-

- (a) the number of votes polled for each candidate, by polling divisions;
- (b) the number of rejected ballots;
- (c) the number of names on the revised lists of electors and on the lists of special electors; and
- (d) any other information that it may deem fit to include; and,

shall forthwith forward a copy of the report to the persons respectively set out in subrule (5) (b)." The persons set out in the said subrule (5) (b) as being the persons to whom a copy of the report should be sent in the case of a Tobago House of Assembly Election, are the Minister and the Chief Administrator of the Tobago House of Assembly.

In compliance therewith, the Commission now submits to you its printed Report on the Tobago House of Assembly Elections held on January 17, 2005. It sets out in Appendix I the number of votes polled for each candidate by polling division and the number of rejected ballots; and in Appendix II the number of names on the revised lists of electors and on the lists of special electors.

The data contained in Appendices III, IV, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX and X are provided under Rule 108(6)(d).
