Rule 108(6) of the Election Rules of the Subsidiary Legislation of the Representation of the People Act, Chapter 2:01 (the Act) specifies that the Elections and Boundaries Commission (the Commission):

“... shall immediately after each election, cause to be printed a report giving –

- (a) the number of votes polled for each candidate, by polling divisions;
- (b) the number of rejected ballots;
- (c) the number of names on the revised lists of electors and on the list of special electors; and
- (d) any other information that it may deem fit to include;

and shall forthwith forward a copy of the report to the persons respectively set out in sub rule (5)(b).”

The persons named in sub rule (5)(b), in the case of a Tobago House of Assembly election, are:

- The Minister; and
- The Chief Administrator of the Tobago House of Assembly.

Accordingly, the Commission is pleased to submit its report on the Tobago House of Assembly election held on 19<sup>th</sup> January 2009.

The data referred to at (a) and (b) are given at **Appendix I** and those at (c) at **Appendix II**.

The requirements of 108(6) (d) *supra* are met by the following:

## **1. Prologue**

Significantly, the legal basis of the Tobago House of Assembly Election held on 19<sup>th</sup> January 2009 was: "The Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government) (Tobago House of Assembly) Order, 2004 dated 17<sup>th</sup> November 2004 made by the President of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago under Section 4 of the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government) Act and issued as Legal Notice No. 319.

This Presidential Order was based on the Eighth Report of the Elections and Boundaries Commission on the boundaries of the Electoral Districts in the Electoral Area of Tobago dated August 23, 2004.

Reversion to this Order came about in circumstances which militated against the Commission's submission of its Ninth Report.

These circumstances have their genesis in the discovery by the Commission of a number of lacunae in the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government) Act, Chap. 25:50 which necessitated governmental and parliamentary action to rectify the problem.

The relevant legislation, Act 27 of 2008, was assented to by His Excellency the President on 12<sup>th</sup> December 2008, a mere thirty-eight days before the date of the Poll. Evidently it would have been impossible for the Ninth Report of the Commission to be used as a basis for the election on 19<sup>th</sup> January 2009.

However, it is to be noted that Section 10 of Act 27 of 2008 provides as follows:

- "10. Notwithstanding section 4(2)(c) and 4(6) of the Act and any other written law, for the purposes only of the Tobago House of Assembly elections in 2009, the Report and the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government) (Tobago House of Assembly) Order, 2004, shall subsists (*sic*) and remain valid and effectual for the aforementioned elections."

It is noteworthy that the Commission submitted its Ninth Report on the boundaries of the Electoral Districts in the Electoral Area of Tobago to your good self on 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2008.

## **2. Electoral Registration and Nomination of Candidates**

An electoral registration was, in accordance with Section 30 of the Act, directed by His Excellency the President of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago to be held for each of the said Electoral Districts over the period 15<sup>th</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> December 2008 inclusive.

The nomination of candidates was fixed for Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> December 2008. However, since by law an event scheduled to take place on a Saturday or Sunday may take place

“... on the next day not being a Saturday or Sunday ...” the actual nomination of candidates was executed on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> December 2008.

In accordance with the provisions of sub-section (2) of Section 22 of the Tobago House of Assembly Act, Chap. 25:03, Polling Day in each of the twelve Electoral Districts of the Electoral Area of Tobago was fixed for Monday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2009.

### **3. Revised and Supplemental Lists of Electors**

As was stated in “The Report of the Elections and Boundaries Commission on the Tobago House of Assembly Elections held on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> January 2005”, the electorate eligible to vote in that election numbered thirty-eight thousand, six hundred and eight (38,608). For the 19<sup>th</sup> January 2009 Poll the total number of eligible electors was forty-two thousand, six hundred and twenty-three (42,623) which number included the names of nine (9) persons added and thirteen (13) deleted by way of the Supplemental List.

### **4. Polling Stations and Staffing**

Ninety-Seven (97) polling stations were established throughout the electoral area of Tobago to serve electors in the sixty-seven (67) polling divisions. Five Hundred and seven (507) poll-day staff comprising Presiding Officers, Deputy Presiding Officers, Poll Clerks and Officers-in-Charge of Ballot Boxes were selected from a group of over six hundred and fifty (650) who underwent training initially. The total staff complement also included nine (9) Roving Officers and twenty (20) Information Officers who were assigned to selected polling stations.

### **5. Public Education and Publicity**

Pertinent election-related information was disseminated to the electorate via the three (3) indigenous media houses – The Tobago News which is a weekly publication; television Tobago Channel 5 and Radio Tamarind by the Public Education and Public Relations Unit (PEPRU) of the Elections and Boundaries Commission. These media houses broadcast and published several election-related advertisements which comprised radio and television spots and features, as well as newspaper inserts. The information targeted the electorate to assist them in one way or another in the process of exercising their franchise.

The media houses also covered events organized by the Commission, one of which was a ceremony to present the Writs of Election issued by His Excellency, The President to the four (4) Returning Officers by the Chairman of the Elections and Boundaries Commission, at the Mount Irvine Bay Hotel. It was the first time that such a ceremony took place in Tobago, and so reversed the practice of having the Returning Officers come to Trinidad to receive their instruments. The Chairman’s

address to the Returning Officers received media coverage in Tobago and was also transmitted to Trinidad through the Tobago-based journalists.

Election information was also posted by PEPRU on the THA's Information Technology '2 1 1' Contact Centre located throughout Tobago. This was accessed by two hundred and forty-six (246) electors on election-day.

## **6. Contesting Parties and Conduct of the Poll**

At the close of Nomination-Day proceedings, twenty-five (25) candidates had been nominated to contest the election. Twenty-four (24) represented two political parties and there was one (1) Independent.

Parties and the abbreviation of their names, description of party symbols and the number of candidates fielded are as follows:

## **7. Commission's Visits to Polling Stations**

On polling day, the Commission visited forty-four (44) polling stations in ten (10) Electoral Districts and observed the voting process at close hand.

## **8. Results**

The results of the election showed the People's National Movement winning eight (8) seats and the Tobago Organisation of the People four (4), while the Independent candidate was unsuccessful.

The latter failed to obtain the statutory minimum of one-eighth of the total number of votes polled by all the candidates in the Electoral District in which they contested, and accordingly had his deposit forfeited.

## **9. Recounts**

On 20<sup>th</sup> January 2009, the election agent of the PNM candidate for the Electoral District of Canaan/Bon Accord submitted a written request to the incumbent Returning Officer for a final count. The recount commenced at 10:45 a.m. on 21<sup>st</sup> January 2009 and was called off by the said election agent at 2:20 p.m. of the same

day after the ballots from four (4) polling stations had been counted. The outcome of this exercise was the rejection of a ballot counted initially for the PNM candidate whose original tally was accordingly reduced by one.

In the Electoral District of Scarborough/Calder Hall, the Returning Officer of this district received on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2009 at 11:55 a.m. a written request for a recount from an official of the Tobago Organisation of the People (TOP) who was neither the candidate nor election agent as required by Election Rule 101(1). However, based on the oral request made by the election agent of the TOP candidate who had delivered this written request, the Returning Officer commenced the recount at 3:00 p.m. on the same day. Two hours and thirty-five minutes afterwards, by which time the ballots of six (6) polling stations had been recounted, the exercise was called off by the candidate; the ballots of two (2) polling stations remaining unexamined. In the final determination, one (1) ballot for the TOP candidate and three (3) ballots for the PNM candidate were deemed rejected ballots.

The aforementioned recounts did not alter the results of the Poll *status quo ante* in the electoral districts of Canaan/Bon Accord and Scarborough/Calder Hall.

It is to be noted that an official of the TOP had sent written requests to the Returning Officers for the Electoral Districts of Black Rock/Whim/Spring Garden, Plymouth/Golden Lane, Parlatuvier/L'Anse Fourmi/Speyside, Roxborough/Delaford, Buccoo/Mt Pleasant, Bethel/Mt Irvine and Lambeau/Signal Hill seeking recounts of the ballots cast in these districts but these were not entertained on the ground that they did not meet the requirement of Election Rule 101(1) which states *inter alia*:

“Where by 12:00 noon on the day following the closing of the poll neither a candidate nor his agent requests the Returning Officer to conduct a final count the Returning Officer shall confirm the count conducted by the Presiding Officer as set out in his Statement of the Poll.”

## 10. Closure

Based on the Commission's observations, the results of the election appear to be a genuine expression of the will of the people. That they were able to do so freely and fearlessly augurs well for democracy in Tobago.

The data contained in Appendices III, IV, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX and X are provided under Rule 108 (6) (d).


