





Dear Sir

In accordance with Rule 108(6) of the Election Rules made under section 161(1) of the Representation of the People Act, Chapter 2:01 (the Act) the Elections and Boundaries Commission (the Commission) is pleased to submit its report on the Bye-Election for the Municipal Electoral District of Belmont East in the Port-of-Spain Corporation, held on Monday 16th July 2018. The rule states as follows:

"The Commission shall immediately after each election, cause to be printed a report giving-

- (a) the number of votes polled for each candidate, by polling divisions;
- (b) the number of rejected ballots;
- (c) the number of names on the revised lists of electors and on the list of special electors; and
- (d) any other information that it may deem fit to include,

and shall forthwith forward a copy of the report to the persons respectively set out in subrule (5)(b)."

Appendix I contains the data in respect of items (a) and (b) above, while a summary of the information contained in Appendix I is given in Appendix II. The data relating to (c) are tabulated in Appendix III. Information relevant to (d) can be found below and at Appendices IV to XI.

By means of correspondence dated 6th June 2018, from the Secretary to the Cabinet, the Commission was informed that the Honourable Prime Minister had agreed to Monday 16th July, 2018 as the date for the conduct of the Bye-Election in the electoral district of Belmont East in the Port-of-Spain Corporation, as defined in the Schedule to the Elections and Boundaries Commission (Local Government and Tobago House of Assembly) Order, 2016 (Legal Notice No. 127 of August 25, 2016) consequent on the declaration by the said Corporation of a vacancy in the electoral district. The vacancy arose consequent on the death of Mr. Darryl Rajpaul, Councillor.

Appointment of Returning Officer:

Thereafter, Ms. Jennifer Harvey-Bethel was selected as the Returning Officer for the electoral district by the Commission, and the Writ of Election was duly prepared and delivered to Her Excellency, the President on 6th June, 2018.

On behalf of the Commission, the Chairman officially appointed Ms. Harvey-Bethel as Returning Officer, and presented her with the Writ of Election issued by Her Excellency the President on 7th June 2018. Her office was established at 123 Henry Street, Port-of-Spain.

Electoral Registration:

A period of Electoral Registration, as is required by law, was conducted over the period 8th – 17th June 2018 inclusive. It is to be noted that the exclusion of the public holiday of Eidul-Fitr on 15th June 2018 resulted in the nine-day period being extended by one (1) day and, therefore, ended on 17th June, 2018.

Electoral Lists:

The Preliminary List of Electors posted on 8th June, 2018 contained the names of a total of three thousand, two hundred and thirty-four (3,234) electors. Following the Electoral Registration as mentioned above, the number of electors on the Revised List of Electors which was posted on 22nd June, 2018 increased to three thousand, two hundred and thirty-seven (3,237) eligible electors. A supplemental list was not required.

Nomination Day:

On Nomination Day, 25th June 2018, the political parties identified in the table below each fielded a candidate to contest the Bye-Election. All three (3) prospective candidates were duly nominated (see **Appendix VIII**).

Name of Political Party	Abbreviated Initials	Description of Party Symbol
People's Empowerment Party	PEP	The umbrella, three people-like figures holding aloft an umbrella.
People's National Movement	PNM	An oval with a balisier flower inside, at the base the letters PNM and the words People's National Movement.
United National Congress	UNC	The rising sun over the Trinity Hills above the letters U.N.C.

Nomination Day proceedings went smoothly as a result of the preliminary examination of nomination papers held at the office of the Returning Officer on 14th June, 2018.

Polling Stations:

Seven (7) polling stations were established at five (5) locations in the electoral district for the conduct of the poll.

Staffing:

A total of thirty-eight (38) poll-day staff [thirty-six (36) female and two (2) male] were recruited to work in polling stations on poll day, they having undergone training for three (3) days on 20th, 22nd and 23rd June, 2018.

Poll-Day Complaint:

The People's Empowerment Party alleged that there were election paraphernalia from the People's National Movement (PNM) and the United National Congress (UNC) still up, in close proximity to polling station entrances.

It is to be noted that the Commission is bound by the terms of the Representation of the People Act, Chapter 2:01 (the Act). Any offences under that Act are investigated and prosecuted by the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service ("TTPS"). In the case of violations or breaches of that Act, the Commission has no jurisdiction to investigate or prosecute any such breaches.

That being said, the Commission proposes to write to the political parties contesting elections, to request that they remove their election paraphernalia that would have been posted close to polling stations during the run-up to poll-day. A listing of the location of polling stations will be provided to assist in the exercise.

Political parties, in particular those who are signatories, will be reminded to commit to *the Code of Ethical Political Conduct* which was developed by the Council for Responsible Political Behaviour in 2014.

Commission Monitoring:

Members of the Commission visited polling stations in the electoral district to witness the opening and operation of polling stations on poll-day, and were satisfied with the arrangements made by the Returning Officer.

Result of the Poll:

The PNM's candidate, Ms. Nicole Madonna Young, was declared elected by the Returning Officer on 17th July, 2018.

Conclusion:

The Elections and Boundaries Commission is satisfied that the election was conducted according to the Election Rules and the results reflected the will of the electorate.


