Dear Honourable Minister

We are pleased to attach the Report of the Elections and Boundaries Commission (“the Commission”) on the Tobago House of Assembly Election held on Monday January 23, 2017, prepared in compliance with the Representation of the People Act, Chap. 2:01 (the Act) Election Rule 108(6).

The Election Rule requires that the Commission shall “immediately after each election cause to be printed a report giving:

- (a) the number of votes polled for each candidate, by polling divisions;
- (b) the number of rejected ballots;
- (c) the number of names on the revised lists of electors and on the list of special electors; and
- (d) any other information that it may deem fit to include,”

and provides for the submission of a copy of the Report, in the case of a Tobago House of Assembly Election, to the Minister responsible for Local Government and the Chief Administrator of the Tobago House of Assembly.

The data referred to above are provided in this Report as follows:

- (a) and (b) at **Appendices I and II**; and
- (c) at **Appendix III**.

As concerns (d) above, the following information relates. Other pertinent details can be found at **Appendices IV to X**.



## **1. ANNOUNCEMENT OF POLLING AND NOMINATION DATES**

By means of letters, both of which were dated December 14, 2016, the Secretary to His Excellency the President and the Secretary to Cabinet informed the Commission that the date for the Tobago House of Assembly election had been set as Monday January 23, 2017. The letter signed by the former also fixed Nomination Day as Tuesday January 3, 2017.

## **2. ISSUANCE OF WRITS OF ELECTION**

The Commission delivered Writs of Election issued by His Excellency the President to four (**4**) Returning Officers appointed by the Commission, at the Coco Reef Resort and Spa, Tobago on December 19, 2016.

## **3. ELECTORAL REGISTRATION**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 30 of the Act, a nine-day period of electoral registration was conducted from December 19-30, 2016.

While the time-span cited actually amounts to twelve (**12**) **calendar** days, the legal stipulation of nine (**9**) days was not exceeded. This is due to the fact that Christmas Day and two (**2**) additional public holidays, Monday December 26, 2016 and Tuesday December 27, 2016, which fell within the period, had to be excluded in accordance with the provisions of section 159(1) of the Act.

## **4. PRELIMINARY AND REVISED LISTS OF ELECTORS**

The preliminary List of Electors which was posted, as required, on the date of commencement of the electoral registration, reflected an electorate of forty-eight thousand, nine hundred and forty-two (**48,942**). The electoral registration exercise yielded a total of sixty-two (**62**) transactions, comprising two (**2**) new registrations and sixty (**60**) notifications of change of address.

Changes made to the preliminary List of Electors, as a consequence, resulted in an electorate of forty-eight thousand, nine hundred and eighty (**48,980**) on the revised list of electors which was published on 9<sup>th</sup> January, 2017. This figure represented the number of persons eligible to vote at the election.

The Commission determined that it was not necessary to produce a Supplemental List of Electors as there were no instances of inadvertence in the preparation of the revised list.

## **5. NOMINATION DAY PROCEEDINGS**

At the close of Nomination Day proceedings on Tuesday January 3, 2017, thirty-nine (**39**) candidates representing four (**4**) political parties had been nominated to contest the election.

The names of those parties, abbreviations of their names, and the number of candidates nominated by each party are as follows:

## 6. ESTABLISHMENT AND STAFFING OF POLLING STATIONS

One hundred and one (**101**) polling stations were established to serve electors in the sixty-seven (**67**) polling divisions contained in the twelve (**12**) electoral districts of Tobago. Of the six hundred and six (**606**) persons who were trained in polling station and related poll-day activities, five hundred and fifty-four (**554**) were recruited to fill the positions of Presiding Officer, Deputy Presiding Officer, Poll Clerk, Officer-in-Charge of the Ballot Box, Information Officer and Roving Officer.

The gender composition of the 554 poll-day staff was:

Female	-	512; and
Male	-	42.

## 7. VALIDATION OF THE DATE FOR THE TAKING OF THE POLL

On January 17, 2017, seven (**7**) days before Election Day, Mr. Hochoy Charles, former Chief Secretary of the Tobago House of Assembly and current leader of the Platform of Truth political party, raised questions as to the legality of an election to be held on January 23, 2017. Mr. Charles took the position that an election held on the fixed date would be illegal, since the requirement of Election Day "being not less than twenty-one days after Nomination Day", as prescribed in section 33(3) of the Act, would not be met. The nomination of candidates had, by this time, taken place on January 3, 2017 and he contended that the twenty one day requirement would have been January 24, 2017.

He threatened to seek the intervention of the High Court, if necessary.

The situation arose primarily because of the tight time-frame which had to be observed for the holding of the election. To wit, Writs of Election having been issued by His Excellency the President on December 14, 2016, the earliest date on which the nomination of candidates could properly take place, with said date "being not less

than fourteen days after the day of issue of the writ" (section 33(3)(a) of the Act refers), was December 31, 2016.

This date fell on a Saturday, and Monday January 2, 2017 which would otherwise have served the purpose, had been declared a public holiday and, consequently, had to be excluded. The application of the provisions of section 159 of the Act, resulted in Tuesday January 3, 2017 being the first possible date on which the nomination exercise could take place.

Section 159 of the Act is reproduced hereunder:

- (1) *In reckoning time for the purpose of this Act or of the Rules made thereunder Saturdays and Sundays shall be included; but Christmas Day, Good Friday and any other public holiday shall be excluded.*
- (2) *Where anything required by or under this Act to be done falls on a Saturday or Sunday or on any excluded day, that thing may be done on the next day not being a Saturday, a Sunday or one of the excluded days.*

Section 33(3)(b) of the Act provides that the day on which the poll shall be taken shall not be less than twenty-one (21) days after nomination day.

The matter was resolved by the enactment of Act No. 1 of 2017 cited as the Tobago House of Assembly Election (Validation) Act, 2017. The Bill which primarily sought to validate the date on which the election was scheduled to be held, non-compliance with 33(3)(b) notwithstanding, was passed in the House of Representatives on Friday January 20, 2017. It was passed in the Senate on Saturday January 21, 2017 and assented to by His Excellency the President on January 21, 2017. This enabled the election to proceed as scheduled.

## 8. RESULTS

The People's National Movement won ten (**10**) seats and the Progressive Democratic Patriots won two (**2**) seats.

Thirty (**30**) of the candidates who contested the election, having either won or polled at least one eighth ( $\frac{1}{8}$ ) of the total number of votes polled by all the candidates in their respective electoral districts, qualified for a refund of their deposit. The other nine (**9**) candidates forfeited their deposits.

Twenty four thousand, three hundred and forty-two (**24,342**) electors (out of **48,980**) exercised their right to vote. This represented a voter turnout of **49.7%**.

## 9. CHALLENGE TO PRELIMINARY RESULTS

A challenge to the preliminary result of the poll, as announced by the Returning Officer for the electoral district of Goodwood/Belle Garden West following the close of the poll, was made in accordance with the Election Rules by the PDP candidate. A recount of all of the ballots cast in the district was requested.

The recount commenced at 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday January 24, 2017, and was called off by the candidate who had made the request at approximately 6:30 p.m. There was no change to the preliminary result.

## 10. COMMISSION'S VISITS TO POLLING STATIONS

On polling day members of the Commission visited polling stations in the twelve (12) electoral districts, and were satisfied that the process worked well.
